Thriving Communities is a new national support programme for voluntary, community, faith and social enterprise groups, supporting communities in England, working alongside social prescribing (SP) link workers. This regional offer is hosted by Community Action Derby, a local infrastructure in Derbyshire

You will have the chance to create partnerships with fellow community groups and other professionals across the health and local authority system to sustain your work in the long term.

- 3) Working with your fellow organisations and NHS and local authority partnerships. Get connected to help deliver Social Prescribing together.

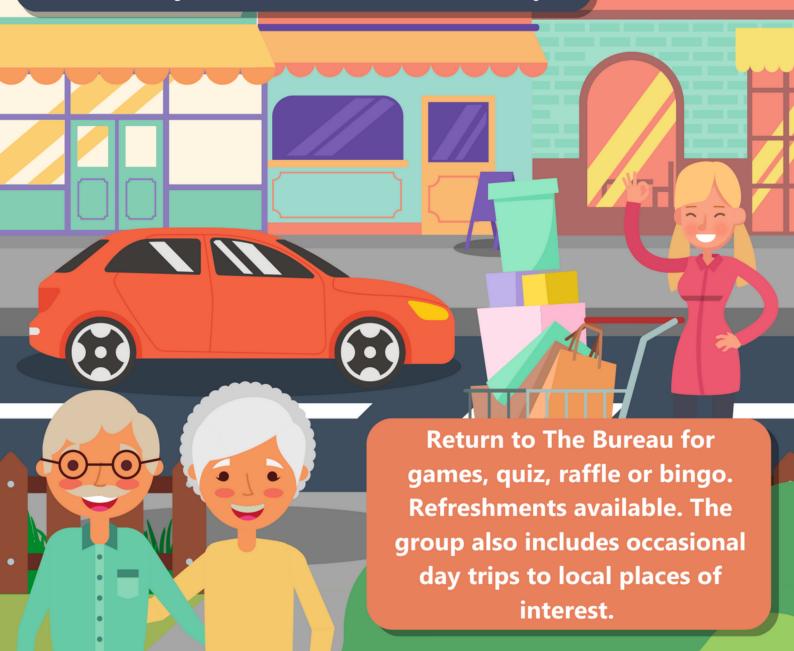
