### Virus Case Numbers in High Peak

Here is the current Covid-19 data for Glossopdale for the previous 7 days.

Hadfield West and Gamesley	35	Total of <b>332</b>
Dinting, Simmondley and Charlesworth	45	
Glossop	56	
Hadfield East and Tintwistle	32	
Rest of High Peak	164	

This is another week on week rise. Remember - Anyone who has been contacted by test & trace or with any of the three main symptoms of Covid-19 **must self-isolate immediately** for 10 days, even if your home testing kit says you are negative. The three main symptoms are:

- A new, continuous cough
- A high temperature
- A loss or change to their sense of smell or taste

### Self-Isolation Eased for Fully Vaccinated Adults in Step 4

From 16<sup>th</sup> August, double jabbed individuals and under 18s will no longer need to self-isolate if they are identified as a close contact of someone with Covid-19. Read more [here](#).

### Prime Minister Sets Out Plans to Ease Restrictions at Step 4

Covid-19 restrictions are set to end in England from step 4 of the Roadmap on July 19<sup>th</sup> after the Prime Minister set out how life will soon return to normal.

Social distancing to end, facemasks will no longer be mandatory and no limits on gatherings. All venues closed can safely reopen with no capacity limits. Read more [here](#).

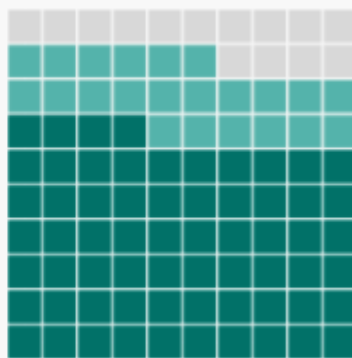
Percentage of adult population
