Below is a roundup of the latest coronavirus news for Glossopdale, as well as other useful information that you might be interested in.

### Virus Case Numbers in High Peak

This week we have some more specific data for virus case numbers in the High Peak for the past 7 days:

Hadfield West and Gamesley	9	Total
Dinting Simmondley and Charlesworth	8	54
Glossop	7	
Hadfield East and Tintwistle	6	
Rest of High Peak	24	

It is so important that we remain vigilant and continue following Government guidelines, particularly as we continue through the roadmap and see more services opening up. Please make sure you continue to do your home lateral flow tests to keep an eye on this increase in our area and remember – hands, face, space!

### Testing in Glossopdale

As a result of the spike in infections in Gamesley, we had a 2 day surge testing operation in this area, with over **900** tests taken. This was a brilliant outcome and Public Health will shortly learn if they picked up any positive tests. Thank you to all involved – to those who took tests, the volunteers going door to door and the teams who coordinated the efforts!

Don't forget, we are being encouraged to look out for a wider range of symptoms other than the usual (temperature, cough, change to smell or taste) such as a tummy ache, sore throat, loss of appetite, diarrhoea, feeling or being sick, headaches, joint pain, muscle ache, runny nose, sneezing, feeling drowsy, tiredness, muscle aches or generally feeling poorly.

## Vaccine Update

Everyone aged 25 and over can now get the COVID-19 vaccine. You can book appointments at a larger vaccination centre or pharmacy now, or wait to be invited to go to a local NHS vaccine centre. Last Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> June there was also a pop-up vaccine centre in Gamesley which was offering first doses to anyone between the ages of 30 and 40. The day was incredibly successful, with over 400 doses given and almost no wastage. Fantastic work from the Glossop Health Team!
